

De Lacy Motor Club 'Seven Dales' Heritage Run 2024.



Regulations.

ORGANISATION

- 1. De Lacy Motor Club Ltd will stage the 10th running of the 'Seven Dales Heritage Run', a Touring Assembly on Sunday 2nd June 2024.
- 2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by MSUK, these regulations and any written instructions that may be issued for the event. The MSUK Permit/Certificate of Exemption for this event is No. 136020

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- 3. The event is open to all cars, but historic, classics and interesting or sporting modern cars would be especially welcome.
- **4.** All cars should be presented in good condition: The Organisers reserve the right to decline any car showing damage. Each car must be taxed for the road, and have a valid MOT Certificate if applicable.
- **5.** Participating cars will be identified by a Rally Plate, which will be supplied by the organisers. This should be displayed in prominent forward facing position on the front of the vehicle. The organisers reserve the right to exclude any vehicle which, in their opinion, is unsuitable for participation in the Run. Cars must not carry any competition numbers anywhere on the vehicle.

INSURANCE

6. All entrants must ensure that their cars have adequate insurance to enter the event. This being a Touring Assembly with a MSUK Certificate of Exemption, their Public Liability Policy covers the event. However, this does not cover vehicle insurance under the Road Traffic Acts. A standard motor car policy may well cover the use of the car on a public highway. If in doubt, please seek advice from your insurance company.

ENTRIES

- 7. Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on Wednesday 22nd May 2024 or before, if the maximum number of entries is met. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of £17.50 for two people* travelling in the car. The entry fee includes one Road Book and one souvenir Rally Plate. * As the route will be provided on the day via tulip notes from the road book, the organiser's feel that each participating vehicle for health & safety reasons should have a minimum crew of two.
- 8. Entry Forms and fees should be sent to the Secretary of the Event. (See paragraph 16a) Payment can be made by Cheque / Cash or BACs payments: (BAC's Account Name: De Lacy Motor Club. Sort Code: 05 05 50, Account Number: 36476539. Please make your reference as your SURNAME/HR. (Cheques please make payable to De Lacy Motor Club). The Entry Form can then be emailed or posted to the Secretary.
- **9.** The maximum number of cars on the event is 50 but this may be increased at the organiser's discretion. The minimum is 20. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and refund entry fees in full. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then this should be noted on the entry form, and we will do our best to accommodate you.
- 10. Each entry will be acknowledged by email unless you indicate preference for post on the Entry Form. The cost of entries withdrawn in writing received prior to Wednesday 22nd May will be refunded in full. Thereafter, refunds will be at the Organisers' discretion, 3 or fewer days before the run nil, within 4 -10 to days of the run 50%.
- 11. Final Instructions will be issued not later than 5 days before the run, **preferably by email** or by post if requested.

DOCUMENTATION

12. Cars & crews should arrive at the Start at Sherburn Aero Club, New Lennerton Lane, Sherburn in Elmet, Leeds LS25 6JE. Map 105/527332 (https://www.sherburnaeroclub.com/) from 09.15am and no later than 10.00am. Follow the signs to the dedicated parking area. You will have time to "Sign On", fit your rally plate and get your breakfast items, and chat to fellow entrants. At Signing On, crews will be issued with a Pack, containing the Road Book, Rally Plate, meal tickets and other items.

There will be a driver's briefing inside the aero Club at 10.00 - 10.15am which it is essential you attend

13. Before the start, an optional Hot drink & Bacon/Sausage/Vegetarian Sandwich package will be available at a cost of £6.00 these will need to be pre-ordered on the entry form and included within your entry fee.

ROUTE

14a. Start: Sherburn Aero Club.

The first car will leave at 10.31 am. Cars will start at one-minute intervals to avoid bunching, and must proceed very quietly along New Lennerton Lane. Your start time will be issued in the final instructions issued about a week before the event. We do ask that you proceed to the start to ensure departure on your due time. Please start at your scheduled start time

14b. Finish: Breighton Aero Club. www.realaero.com

Cars will finish the run at Breighton Aero Club, Breighton Airfield, Selby, YO8 6DS. Please be aware: NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed anywhere on the site An optional Hot drink and cake package will be available at the café at a cost of £5.00, these will need to be pre-ordered on the entry form and payment included within your entry fee. If on the day you do not intend to return to the aero club finish we would ask you let us know by telephoning Mike Brownlow on 07770730774, so that we don't hang around waiting for you.

14c. The route will cover approximately 85 miles on asphalt roads in Yorkshire. The route will be given in an easy to follow "Tulip" Road Book, **and should take you around 3 - 4 hours at a steady pace. There is no Midway Halt.** Places will be available on the route for refreshments/toilets.

15. The organisers are concerned at the speed some entrants have travelled at in past events, especially on narrow lanes. As ever, we ask you to be mindful of other road users, particularly cyclists, horse riders and walkers. There is no average speed to keep to: don't speed, but don't dawdle either! Please avoid driving along in convoys.
