Welcome to the ATL Carlisle Stages Rally

- Noise test and Scrutineering is on Friday 7th June 2019, at H & H Auctions, , Borderway Mart, Rosehill, Carlisle CA1 2RS, - Map Ref 85/428 557¾
- Once you are in the Car Park please drive with great care.
- Noise Test within the venue will be open from 14.00 to 19.00 hrs, please present your car within this time.
- Decals and Numbers will be available from inside the Scrutineering Hall.
- Scrutineering Cards will be issued at Noise Test.
- Scrutineering is located inside the Exhibition Hall, please follow marshals directions.

Rally Maps

- Crews will be issued with an A3 black & white event overview map for the Service Crew, if they need to come and find you!
- Crews will also be issued with a set of A4 black and white stage maps

Management Service

Management Service is not allowed on the event, penalty for being observed shall be Exclusion from the results.

Road Book

You should receive an E-version of your Road Book with these Final Instructions, a hard copy will be issued at documentation.

Start of the Event

The event will start on Saturday 8th June at 08.31 at MTC 1 at H&H Auctions.

Two wheeled drive cars will start the event first in reverse seeded order, followed by a 5 minute gap then 4 wheeled drive cars in seeded order.

Rejoin Locations

In accordance with the rejoin regulations R.40.1.6 the following controls, competitors will be allowed to rejoin the event if they miss a stage or control are per R.40.1.7: MTC 3.

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The missing of a stage will be penalized with a stage maximum plus 15 minutes per stage.

Tightened Junctions / Chicanes

Tightened Junctions and Chicanes have been placed at five locations around the event to keep the average speed of the stage under 70mph.

These locations are made from Traffic Cones, Orange netting, pallets and Tyres, the deliberate shortcutting through the material of the chicane or Tightened junction will be penalized in the first instance with the penalty of Stage Maximum, not performing a stage correctly per R.32.2(c), and for a second offence the penalty is Disqualification.

Pattersons - DVD

We can confirm that the road from Junction 7 to Junction 8 on Kershope has been regraded, since the notes were made.

Biosecurity in Newcastleton Forest

After the stage and before joining the public highway at Kershope Bridge all vehicles will be required to be washed.

H & H Auctions

The service area is a mixture of hardstanding and rolled broken stone, you must use a groundsheet or tarpaulin. For safety please use a board when using jacks on cars.

Refreshments and Toilets are located within the Exhibition Building used as the Scrutineering venue.

Support Vehicles

Support vehicles are allowed in the service area.

End of Leg Road Section

In accordance with Blue Book Regulation GR.R.30.3.3, competitors are allowed to check in advance of their due time. Competitors arriving early must have their due time entered on the time card; those arriving later than their due time must have their actual time of arrival entered.

Overnight Parking in Service Areas

No area will be classed as 'secure', so all vehicles are left at your own risk. Service vehicles and trailers may also be left in these areas. There will be people sleeping overnight in the Service Areas however.

MSA News

The MSA have requested that we remind competitors of the following:

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Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code. Any injury incidents must be reported to the Police Authority. Details must also be included in the Stewards Report therefore the Secretary of the Rally MUST be informed.

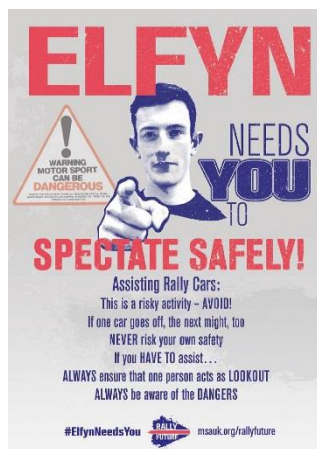
