Thai Green Curry with sweet chilli sticky rise £9.50

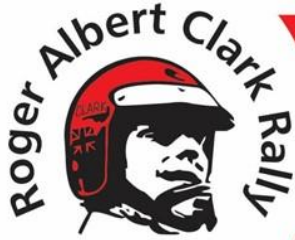

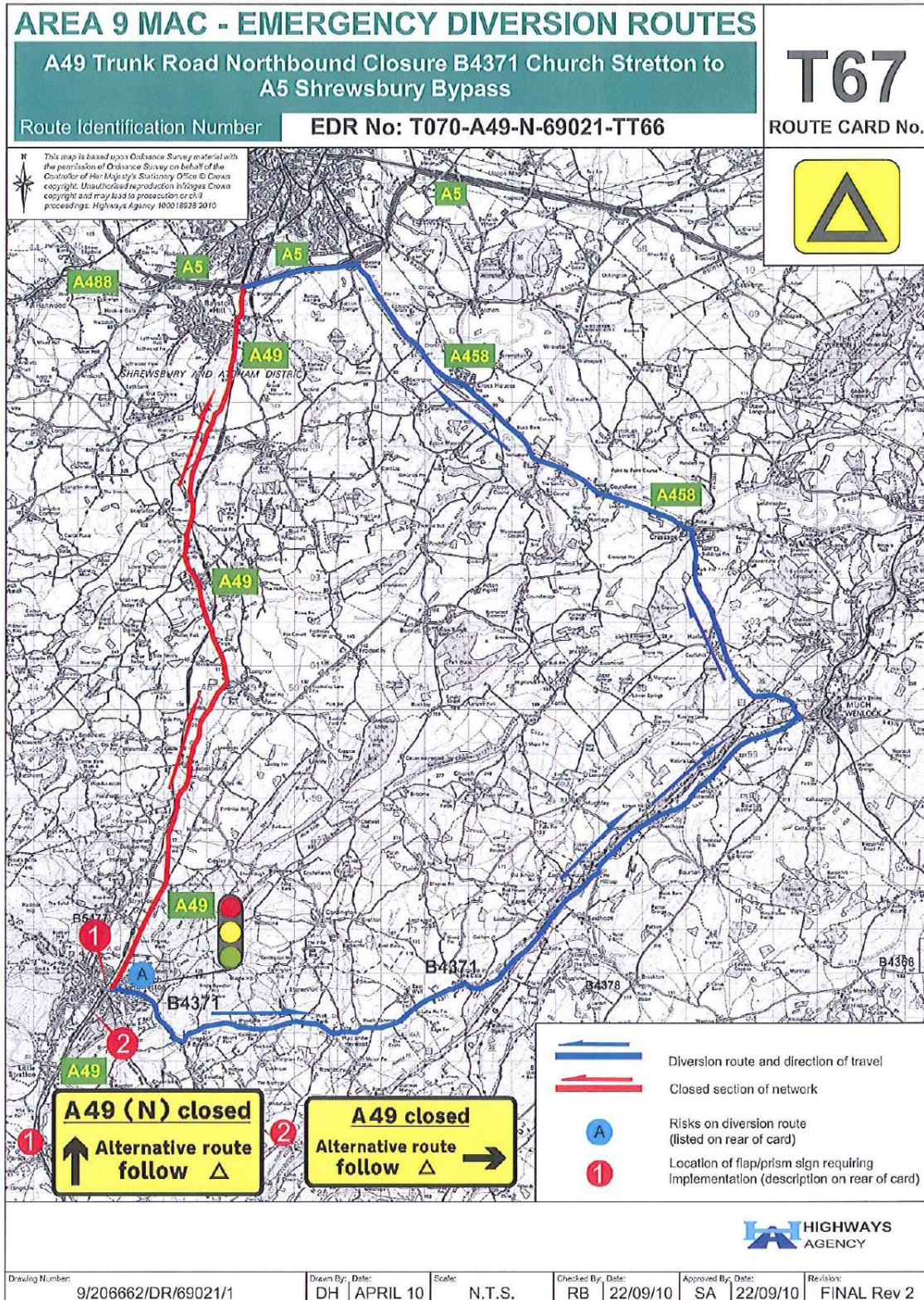

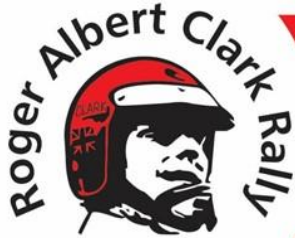
