

Enclosed with these Instructions are your Road Books, Event Maps, Door Squares, Front Bonnet and Rear External Window Plates and associate sponsor decals.

Noise test and Scrutineering is on Thursday 9th November 2017.

Noise Test will be located at the entrance to Scrutineering and will be open from 12:00 noon to 19:45 hrs, please present your car within this time.

Scrutineering opens from 12.00 noon, and closes at 20.00 hrs.

Once you are in the Car Park please drive with great care.

Scrutineering Space is on Hard Standing, and has flood lights.

Please park trailers at the bottom of the car park on the grassed area.

Scrutineering Cards will be issued at Noise Test.

Scrutineering is located inside the Building, please follow the enclosed map.

Foreign Crews who do not have an FIA Technical Passport will require an MSA issued Competition Car Log Book (CCLB) and MSA HRVIF papers these will be issued at scrutineering if you require this please arrive early, this process can be undertaken on Wednesday 7th from 10.00 hrs onwards.

If foreign crews are not able to attend on the Wednesday 7th they **MUST** inform the Rally Office to make alternative arrangements.

Brightwells is located at the junction of the A44 and A49 north of Leominster, Post Code HR6 0DE Overnight parking is allowed.

For the Management Pack you will also receive a Competitors Map Book, and a full Road Book for the event, these are enclosed.

If you have ordered a Support Pack you will also receive a Service Overview Map and this will be enclosed.

Road Book

Black Lines in the Road Book next to the tulips and Information box mean that not only can you not service in this area, but your Management Car can not wait for the crew.

These areas have been placed in the road book for a purpose, please do not abuse these lines. You will be watched and penalised accordingly, your Management Crew saying 'I don't know what it means' does not count. You have been warned!!

Emergency Service is allowed after every stage, but please take note of the Black Lines in the Road Book and Emergency Service Instructions.

When servicing on the side of the road please pay attention to your location and local residents. Please ask you Management Crews to take care and take home any rubbish.

If you abuse this type of Emergency Servicing rules then in future years they will be taken away. Please speak to your crews and brief them, I do take this issue seriously and will stop and speak to crews who are not following the rules.



Refuelling of Cars

The refuelling of vehicles will be a major factor on the event as there are few fuel stations along the route that can be used.

Within the event regulation I would like to bring to your attention the following:

Article 17 Item 11.

All servicing work carried out and the carrying of fuel must comply with H & SE Regulations. The refuelling of competitors cars should where available be undertaken at Petrol Station Forecourts along the route. Where this is not available the refuelling of competitors' cars from management cars should be undertaken as the last task on the competition car. The Management Car should carry a fire extinguisher and the management crew to be aware of how to use the extinguisher should a fire break out during the refuel process. The Health and Safety of Management car crew and Competition crews must also be put first during the process of refuelling cars. Further guidance of vehicle fuel storage is available from the Health & Safety Executive website: http://www.hse.gov.uk/fireandexplosion/petrol-storage-club-association.htm

The refuelling from Management Cars is being allowed along the route on Road Sections within the first mile of each road section following a special stage, otherwise fuel has to be taken at petrol stations along the route, or Service Area's.

Running Order for Competitors

As you are aware the Roger Albert Clark Rally and Roger Albert Clark Open Rally are being run concurrently GR.R.24.1.4.

Parade of Cars Through Leominster

The Council have asked if competitors at 17.30 hrs if they are available to line up at Brightwells exit for a driving parade through the streets of Leominster for about 20 minutes, I hope many of you will be able to attend and bring the town to a standstill to publicise the event.



Start of the Event

The event starts from MTC 1 at Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb, from Brightwells the road section is 23.40 miles and if you are travelling from Brightwells please allow 45 minutes.

Cars in the top 15 are requested to be at Shelsley Walsh 30 minutes before their due time for publicity purposes.

At the end of each leg the competitors will be reseeded in order of finishing the previous leg.

Class Amalgamation


No classes have been amalgamated for award purposes. The following classes will be awarded to 2nd in Class C2, C3, C5, D3, D4, D5, G2, J4, J5 The following classes will be awarded to 3rd in Class C3, D3, D5, G2

Yellow Flags

Yellow Flag procedure will be utilised on the following stages: SS 3 & 6 Radnor SS 8 & 11 Whitehill SS 9 & 12 Roughside SS 14 & 16 harwood SS 17 & 19 Greskine SS 18 & 20 Windyhill SS 21 & 24 Twiglees SS 27 & 29 Capelstone Fell SS 28 & 30 Falstone

Blue Book 24.4.5. On the above special stage where extreme circumstances make it necessary to authorise the movement of non-competing or rescue vehicles before the stage is cleared of competing cars, a system of Yellow Flags is in place.

Yellow Flags are located at the mid stage rescue point and all locations where a rescue/emergency vehicle may re-enter the stage following a short cut and at each radio location these vehicles subsequently pass. All Yellow Flag locations are marked on the 1:25,000 Map Book.



Yellow Flags can only be displayed on the specific instruction of the Clerk of Course or Stage Commander. Yellow Flags must only be used when there is a possibility of non-competing vehicles and rescue vehicles moving on stage AHEAD of competing cars.

Any competitor shown a Yellow Flag will be given a notional time for the stage.

Blue Book 25.6.4 On Passing a Yellow Flag displayed by a marshal wearing a tabard, the driver MUST immediately and significantly reduce speed as well as being prepared to stop at any time; at no time must they overtake any safety vehicle they encounter on the special stage route. The driver must then follow the instructions of any marshals and/or stage safety personnel and maintain this reduced speed until leaving the special stage.

Failure to comply with this rule will incur a penalty at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Subjective Route Notes / Supplied Maps

These can be ordered from Patterson Pacenotes on +44 028 90 844111, notes will not be available from Documentation.

Those crews who are not using notes but will be using the event supplied maps, will run for a special award, you will be asked at Documentation which you will be using. For these crews the organisers will be setting up at least 1 secret Note check each day of the event in accordance with MSA GR R24.11- R24.11.1. Penalty for the finding of any Notes in the vehicle will be in accordance with MSA GR R32.2.q – Exclusion and reported to MSA.

Brightwells Complex

The service area is hardstanding, you must use a groundsheet or tarpaulin. Trailers must be parked at the bottom of the car park on the grassed area

Refreshments and Toilets will be available within Brightwells

Epynt Service

The Service Area is on a loose stone surface within the Quarry area on Epynt ranges, and will be open to receive Service Crews from 11:00 hrs, the first Competitor is due at 14:17 hrs. A Refreshment wagon has been arranged for the venue, toilets are located in the car park.



H & H Auctions, Carlisle

The Service Area is only being used on the event for overnight parking and servicing, it will be open all Friday night / Saturday morning to accept crews, overnight security has been arranged. On the Sunday night you are asked to park in a different area when you arrive on site due to the early morning animal sale on Monday, please follow the instructions by the marshals on the Saturday night when you arrive.

Kielder Greenside Service

This is a new Service Area and has only previously been used by one event, the area is a loose well rolled surface and is opposite the Kielder Waterside, Leaplish activity centre. It will be open to receive Service Crews from 09:30 hrs with the first Competitor is due at 11:10 hrs. A Refreshment wagon has been arranged for the venue, toilets are located in the car park.

Lockerbie Lorry Park Service

The Service Area is on hard standing and will be open to receive Service Crews from 09:00 hrs, the first Competitor is due at 10:50 hrs. Refreshments and Toilets are located within the main building, please use the facilities.

Support vehicles are allowed at all of the service locations with the appropriate pass.

Please ensure you have the correct plate for your vehicle.


Servicing of Vehicles when cars have Finished Each Leg

Competitors are allowed to undertake unlimited servicing of their vehicle at the end of each leg.

There is NO Parc Ferme at the end of each leg.

End of Leg Road Section

In accordance with Blue Book Regulation GR.R.30.3.3, competitors are allowed to check in advance of their due time. Competitors arriving early must have their due time entered on the time card; those arriving later then their due time must have their actual time of arrival entered.



Overnight Parking in Service Areas

No area will be classed as 'secure', so all vehicles are left at your own risk. Service vehicles and trailers may also be left in these areas. There will be people sleeping overnight in the Service Areas however and Security Guards will be provided .

MSA News


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Event by Map Reference
